ELIGIBILITY:

The College Prep Scholars Program is open to high school juniors who demonstrate:

- > **Academic Achievement and Strength in Character:** Primarily A's in the most challenging courses available, strong writing ability, and motivation to succeed. Class rank and test scores are also evaluated, if available.
- > **Financial Need:** Household income of less than \$65,000 annually (for a typical family of four), with minimal assets.

TYPICAL COLLEGE PREP SCHOLARS OFTEN:

- > Rank in the top 5-10% of their class
- > Score greater than 1280 on the SAT or PSAT, or greater than 27 on the ACT (if taken)
- > Are among the first generation in their family to attend a four-year college
- > Qualify for free or reduced-price lunch
